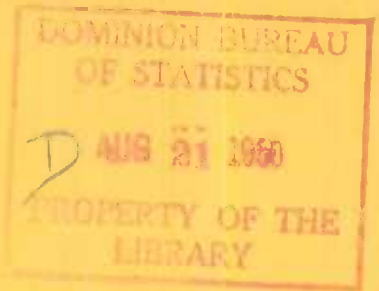

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during March, 1950 totalled 6,989,009 barrels compared with 5,719,387 barrels in March, 1949. The total for the month under review included 3,112,215 barrels of motor gasoline, 27,636 barrels of aviation gasoline, 1,672,634 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 350,635 barrels of diesel fuel, 888,042 barrels of light fuel oil (Nos. 2 and 3), 418,529 barrels of stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 72,251 barrels of tractor fuel, 50,507 barrels of naphtha specialties, and 408,738 barrels of other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 7,405,403 barrels of crude oil during March, 1950 compared with 6,299,445 barrels in March, 1949. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 7,188,606 barrels including 4,926,492 barrels of imported oil and 2,262,114 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the end of the month amounted to 3,477,225 barrels compared with 5,431,974 barrels on the corresponding date of last year.

The consumption of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from refinery shipments and from imports, exports and changes in marketing inventories of refiners, wholesalers and major consumers, was as follows in March, 1950, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons: Naphtha specialties, 80,443; aviation gasoline, 111,973; motor gasoline, 3,355,396; tractor fuel, 18,075; kerosene, 327,598; stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 821,838; diesel fuel, 679,673; light fuel oil (Nos. 2 and 3), 2,807,705; and heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 1,863,594.
