REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

MAY - 1950

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during May, 1950 totalled 8,531,772 barrels compared with 8,608,558 barrels in May, 1949. The total for the month under review included 3,701,108 barrels of motor gasoline, 34,132 barrels of aviation gasoline, 1,943,431 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 523,304 barrels of diesel fuel, 845,632 barrels of light fuel oil (Nos. 2 and 3), 413,812 barrels of stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 200,126 barrels of tractor fuel, 89,682 barrels of naphtha specialties, and 745,016 barrels of other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 9,176,965 barrels of crude oil during May, 1950 compared with 9,233,380 barrels in May, 1949. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 9,805,309 barrels including 7,928,486 barrels of imported oil and 1,876,823 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the end of the month amounted to 4,751,572 barrels compared with 6,459,547 barrels on the corresponding date of last year.

The consumption of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from refinery shipments and from imports, exports and changes in marketing inventories of refiners, wholesalers and major consumers, was as follows in May, 1950, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons: Naphtha specialties, 93,619; aviation gasoline, 130,755; motor gasoline, 5,010,558; tractor fuel, 199,582; kerosene, 73,550; stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 272,086; diesel fuel, 609,742; light fuel oil (Nos. 2 and 3), 735,172; and heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 2,284,888.
