## REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

MARCH - 1951

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during March, 1951 totalled 8,142,256 barrels compared with 6,289,009 barrels in March, 1950. The total for the month under review included 3,559,392 barrels of motor gasoline, 19,828 barrels of aviation gasoline, 1,814,401 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 253,370 barrels of diesel fuel, 1,100,592 barrels of light fuel oil (Nos. 2 and 3), 693,803 barrels of stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 32,636 barrels of tractor fuel, 67,794 barrels of naphtha specialties, and 555,439 barrels of other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 8,687,213 barrels of crude oil during March, 1951 compared with 7,405,403 barrels in March, 1950. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 7,766,865 barrels including 5,551,616 barrels of imported oil and 2,215,249 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the end of the month amounted to 2,605,996 barrels compared with 3,477,225 barrels on the corresponding date of last year.

The consumption of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from refinery shipments and from imports, exports and changes in marketing inventories of refiners, wholesalers and major consumers, was as follows in March, 1951, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons: Naphtha specialties, 84,043; aviation gasoline, 133,110; motor gasoline, 3,160,431; tractor fuel, 6,939; kerosene, 65,299; stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 925,619; diesel fuel, 499,380; light fuel oil (Nos. 2 and 3), 2,114,776; and heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 2,330,188.
