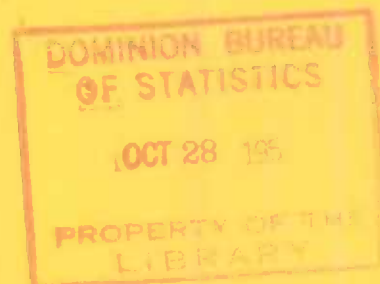

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## REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

JANUARY - 1952

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during January, 1952 totalled 10,474,077 barrels compared with 8,670,693 barrels in January, 1951. The total for the month under review included 4,858,580 barrels of motor gasoline, 26,170 barrels of aviation gasoline, 2,308,821 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 473,379 barrels of diesel fuel, 1,381,031 barrels of furnace oil, 144,879 barrels of other light fuel oil, 606,717 barrels of stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 19,230 barrels of aviation turbine fuel, 71,145 barrels of naphtha specialties, and 581,849 barrels of other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 10,826,211 barrels of crude oil during January, 1952 compared with 9,541,411 barrels in January, 1951. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 9,176,374 barrels including 6,107,797 barrels of imported oil and 3,068,577 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the end of the month amounted to 6,533,698 barrels compared with 3,908,423 barrels on the corresponding date of last year.

The approximate consumption of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada was as follows in January, 1952, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons: Naphtha specialties, 76,992; aviation gasoline, 183,565; motor gasoline, 3,508,924; tractor fuel, 3,082; aviation turbine fuel, 27,398; kerosene, 94,503; stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 1,279,674; diesel fuel, 609,041; furnace oil, 3,436,973; other light fuel oil, 185,289; and heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 2,833,306.

Beginning with January, 1952, a change has been made in the method of compiling the consumption figures. Formerly the disappearance of supply was calculated from refinery shipments of Canadian-made products plus total imports into Canada, less exports and plus or minus changes in wholesalers' inventories. However, the bulk of the imports are received at refineries and become part of the general refinery stocks making it difficult or impossible to break down the subsequent refinery shipments as between domestic and imported products. The new method of arriving at consumption figures records the total refinery shipments whether of domestic origin or imported but the figures on imports do not include the amounts brought in by the refining companies. A separate table on total imports has been added to the report. In addition the new procedure allows for interprovincial and inter-product transfers at the marketing level.

Canada's consumption of petroleum products has doubled since the close of the war and has shown a five-fold increase since 1931. The following figures indicate the trend in the crude oil supply over the past twenty years.
