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REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

FEBRUARY - 1952

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during February, 1952 totalled 9,801,800 barrels, compared with 7,199,016 barrels in February, 1951. The total for the month under review included 4,433,568 barrels of motor gasoline, 37,781 barrels of aviation gasoline, 2,173,211 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 399,780 barrels of diesel fuel, 1,297,734 barrels of furnace oil, 193,110 barrels of other light fuel oil, 532,122 barrels of stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 14,307 barrels of aviation turbine fuel, 58,050 barrels of naphtha specialties, and 559,115 barrels of other refinery products, such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 10,236,722 barrels of crude oil during February, 1952, compared with 8,300,702 barrels in February, 1951. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 8,569,690 barrels, including 5,861,315 barrels of imported oil and 2,708,375 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the end of the month amounted to 4,866,666 barrels, compared with 3,526,344 barrels on the corresponding date of last year.

The approximate consumption of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada was as follows in February, 1952, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons: Naphtha specialties, 66,844; aviation gasoline, 163,046; motor gasoline, 3,337,782; tractor fuel, 3,736; aviation turbine fuel, 29,675; kerosene, 70,955; stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 1,037,623; diesel fuel, 538,868; furnace oil, 2,797,684; other light fuel oil, 186,144; and heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 2,394,847.
