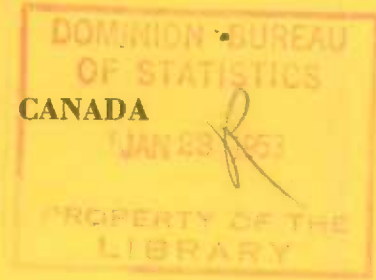

REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

SEPTEMBER - 1952

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during September, 1952 totalled 12,016,869 barrels compared with 10,676,985 barrels in September, 1951. The total for the month under review included 5,538,588 barrels of motor gasoline, 53,219 barrels of aviation gasoline, 2,412,596 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 749,890 barrels of diesel fuel, 1,237,001 barrels of furnace oil, 185,683 barrels of other light fuel oil, 510,988 barrels of stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 74,845 barrels of tractor fuel, 8,710 barrels of aviation turbine fuel, 78,583 barrels of naphtha specialties, and 1,144,197 barrels of other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 12,897,913 barrels of crude oil during September, 1952 compared with 11,794,679 barrels in September, 1951. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 13,406,082 barrels including 7,012,347 barrels of imported oil and 6,393,735 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the end of the month amounted to 9,655,156 barrels compared with 8,680,988 barrels on the corresponding date of last year.

The consumption of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from refinery shipments and from imports, exports and changes in marketing inventories of refiners, wholesalers and major consumers, was as follows in September, 1952, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons: Naphtha specialties, 87,806; aviation gasoline, 245,152; motor gasoline, 6,368,414; tractor fuel, 38,792; aviation turbine fuel, 35,894; kerosene, 31,344; stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 499,768; diesel fuel, 848,854; furnace oil, 1,102,196; other light fuel oil, 118,386; and heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 2,731,890.

Consumption of crude petroleum by Canadian refineries was 2½ times greater in 1951 than in 1940. The use of Canadian crude in 1951 was six times that of 1940, and consumption of imported oil doubled during this eleven-year period.
