REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

OCTOBER - 1953

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during October, 1953 totalled 12,549,550 barrels compared with 12,300,997 barrels in October, 1952. The total for the month under review included 5,530,888 barrels of motor gasoline, 51,812 barrels of aviation gasoline, 2,464,403 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 705,799 barrels of diesel fuel, 1,630,474 barrels of furnace oil, 122,098 barrels of other light fuel oil, 777,822 barrels of stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 847 barrels of tractor fuel, 137,995 barrels of aviation turbine fuel, 88,643 barrels of naphtha specialties, and 1,060,559 barrels of other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 13,641,514 barrels of crude oil during October, 1953, compared with 13,288,385 barrels in October, 1952. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 13,436,457 barrels including 6,348,119 barrels of imported oil and 7,088,338 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the end of the month amounted to 10,525,768 barrels compared with 10,568,731 barrels on the corresponding date of last year.

The consumption of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from refinery shipments and from imports, exports and changes in marketing inventories of refiners, wholesalers and major consumers, was as follows in October, 1953, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons; Naphtha specialties, 84,212; aviation gasoline, 241,422; motor gasoline, 6,622,057; tractor fuel, 25,585; aviation turbine fuel, 108,211; kerosene, 64,913; stove oil (No.1 fuel oil), 803,475; diesel fuel, 944,876; furnace oil, 1,576,081; other light fuel oil, 142,865; and heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 3,142,823.
