REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

DECEMBER - 1953

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during December, 1953, totalled 13,190,981 barrels compared with 11,848,146 barrels in December, 1952. The total for the month under review included 5,961,855 barrels of motor gasoline, 42,155 barrels of aviation gasoline, 2,946,980 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 621,677 barrels of diesel fuel, 1,789,919 barrels of furnace oil, 73,168 barrels of other light fuel oil, 883,085 barrels of stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), -40,860 barrels of tractor fuel, 75,976 barrels of aviation turbine fuel, 85,969 barrels of naphtha specialties, and 716,293 barrels of other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 13,534,377 barrels of crude oil during December, 1953, compared with 12,733,906 barrels in December, 1952. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 11,429,242 barrels, including 6,568,518 barrels of imported oil and 4,860,724 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the end of the month amounted to 7,269,236 barrels compared with 10,826,281 barrels on the corresponding date of last year.

The consumption of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from refinery shipments and from imports, exports and changes in marketing inventories of refiners, wholesalers and major consumers, was as follows in December, 1953, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons: Naphtha specialties, 62,887; aviation gasoline, 195,003; motor gasoline, 4,939,515; tractor fuel, 1,549; aviation turbine fuel, 73,072; kerosene, 55,719; stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 1,329,851; diesel fuel, 849,441; furnace oil, 3,792,943; other light fuel oil, 171,089; and heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 3,620,337.
