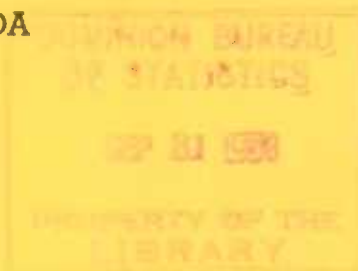

REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

MAY

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during May, 1953, totalled 12,433,051 barrels compared with 10,268,641 barrels in May, 1952. The total for the month under review included 5,403,575 barrels of motor gasoline, 46,990 barrels of aviation gasoline, 2,496,056 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 1,201,716 barrels of diesel fuel, 1,384,552 barrels of furnace oil, 250,825 barrels of other light fuel oil, 390,116 barrels of stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 94,304 barrels of tractor fuel, 113,500 barrels of aviation turbine fuel, 85,986 barrels of naphtha specialties, and 922,515 barrels of other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 12,895,067 barrels of crude oil during May, 1953, compared with 11,202,754 barrels in May, 1952. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 12,974,259 barrels, including 6,511,196 barrels of imported oil and 6,463,063 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the end of the month amounted to 7,723,974 barrels compared with 7,205,221 barrels on the corresponding date of last year.

The consumption of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from refinery shipments and from imports, exports and changes in marketing inventories of refiners, wholesalers and major consumers, was as follows in May, 1953, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons: Naphtha specialties, 86,263; aviation gasoline, 175,035; motor gasoline, 6,619,905; tractor fuel, 57,159; aviation turbine fuel, 121,005; kerosene, 36,286; stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 312,370; diesel fuel, 840,324; furnace oil, 1,173,504; other light fuel oil, 121,867; and 3,161,469 heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6),
