REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

JULY

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during July, 1953, totalled 13,180,672 barrels compared with 12,070,206 barrels in July, 1952. The total for the month under review included 5,866,491 barrels of motor gasoline, 66,318 barrels of aviation gasoline, 2,549,032 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 1,502,114 barrels of diesel fuel, 1,098,200 barrels of furnace oil, 62,211 barrels of other light fuel oil, 478,901 barrels of stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 55,762 barrels of tractor fuel, 139,778 barrels of aviation turbine fuel, 70,623 barrels of naphtha specialties, and 1,295,928 barrels of other refinery products, such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 13,528,927 barrels of crude oil during July, 1953 compared with 12,829,940 barrels in July, 1952. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 14,518,933 barrels, including 7,090,741 barrels of imported oil and 7,428,192 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the end of the month amounted to 10,241,565 barrels compared with 7,980,117 barrels on the corresponding date of last year.

The consumption of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from refinery shipments and from imports, exports and changes in marketing inventories of refiners, wholesalers and major consumers, was as follows in July, 1953, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons: Naphtha specialties, 85,601; aviation gasoline, 301,233; motor gasoline, 7,242,856; tractor fuel, 44,513; aviation turbine fuel, 118,495; kerosene, 36,633; stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 160,926; diesel fuel, 1,042,756; furnace oil, 578,079; other light fuel oil, 121,491; and heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 2,741,510.
