REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

SEPTEMBER - 1953

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during September, 1953, totalled 12,754,524 barrels compared with 12,016,869 barrels in September, 1952. The total for the month under review included 5,841,307 barrels of motor gasoline, 63,624 barrels of aviation gasoline, 2,310,053 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 940,340 barrels of diesel fuel, 1,428,048 barrels of furnace oil, 141,991 barrels of other light fuel oil, 754,879 barrels of stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 13,216 barrels of tractor fuel, 134,298 barrels of aviation turbine fuel, 71,805 barrels of naphtha specialties, and 1,077,512 barrels of other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 13,237,966 barrels of crude oil during September, 1953, compared with 12,897,913 barrels in September, 1952. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 13,927,014 barrels including 6,561,289 barrels of imported oil and 7,365,725 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the end of the month amounted to 10,730,825 barrels compared with 9,655,156 barrels on the corresponding date of last year.

The consumption of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from refinery shipments and from imports, exports and changes in marketing inventories of refiners, wholesalers and major consumers, was as follows in September, 1953, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons: Naphtha specialties, 84,546; aviation gasoline, 256,060; motor gasoline, 7,010,632; tractor fuel, 30,884; aviation turbine fuel, 109,388; kerosene, 46,205; stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 711,457; diesel fuel, 1,016,110; furnace oil, 1,297,006; other light fuel oil, 139,212; and heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 2,858,738.

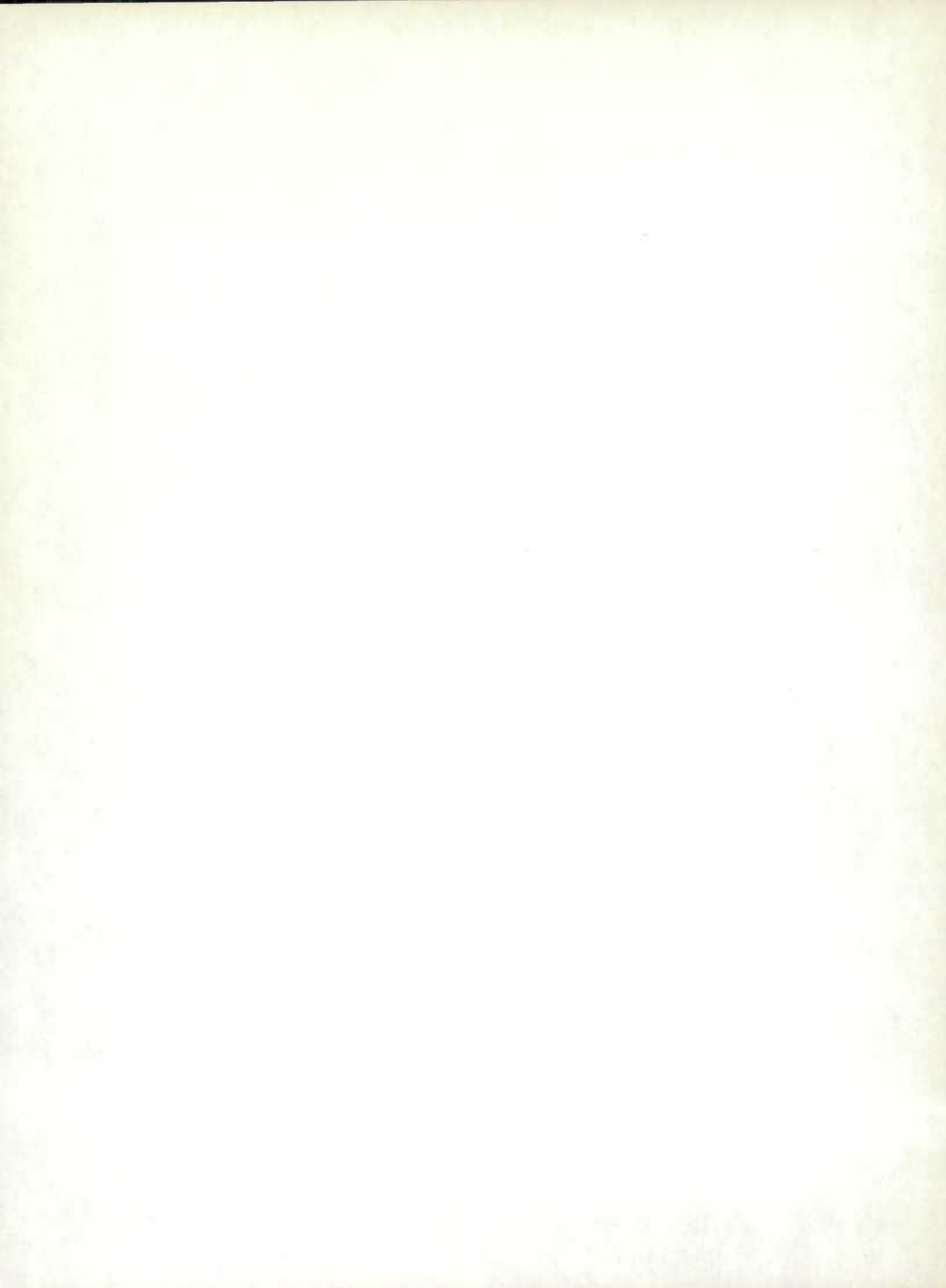
