REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

FEBRUARY - 1954

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during February, 1954, totalled 12,782,666 barrels compared with 10,886,700 barrels in February, 1953. The total for the month under review included 5,396,124 barrels of motor gasoline, 30,982 barrels of aviation gasoline, 2,592,462 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 709,763 barrels of diesel fuel, 1,999,881 barrels of furnace oil, 111,655 barrels of other light fuel oil, 820,383 barrels of stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), -15,384 barrels of tractor fuel, 132,982 barrels of aviation turbine fuel, 95,251 barrels of naphtha specialties, and 802,739 barrels of other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 13,594,555 barrels of crude oil during February, 1954, compared with 11,975,979 barrels in February, 1953. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 12,954,670 barrels, including 5,523,908 barrels of imported oil and 7,430,762 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the end of the month amounted to 5,879,880 barrels compared with 7,976,503 barrels on the corresponding date of last year.

The consumption of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from refinery shipments and from imports, exports and changes in marketing inventories of refiners, wholesalers and major consumers, was as follows in February, 1954, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons: Naphtha specialties, 43,440; aviation gasoline, 170,033; motor gasoline, 3,935,664; tractor fuel, 2,805; aviation turbine fuel, 103,665; kerosene, 39,674; stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 1,327,034; diesel fuel, 689,069; furnace oil, 3,756,083; other light fuel oil, 197,439; and heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 2,825,608.
