Explanatory Notes re Gas Sales

Industrial customers include manufacturers, foundries, machine shops, wholesale bakeries, commercial laundries, etc.

Commercial customers include hotels, restaurants, retail bakers, delicatessens, tailor shops, department stores, wholesale dealers, professional and business offices, etc.

Sales figures represent sales by distributing companies to customers, as well as an estimate of gas used by Industrial consumers who operate their own wells.

Miscellaneous sales include some free customers. The dollar values include some forfeited discounts, penalties, etc., and therefore bear no relationship to the quantities shown.

Explanatory Note re Change in Title

Prior to January, 1958 the statistics appearing in this statement were released as part of a combined report issued as a Memorandum under the title of "Crude Petroleum, Natural Gas and Manufactured Gas". Commencing in January, 1958, these data are being released as separate Memoranda under the titles of "Crude Petroleum and Natural Gas" prepared by the Mineral Statistics Section and the present "Sales of Manufactured and Natural Gas" prepared by the Metal and Chemical Products Section.
