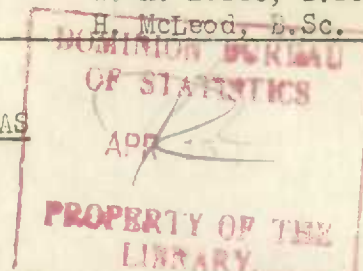

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SALES OF MANUFACTURED AND NATURAL GAS

FEBRUARY, 1943



Sales of manufactured gas by distributing companies in Canada totalled 1,713,987 M cubic feet during February. Of this amount, 763,225 M cubic feet was for domestic use, other than house heating; 442,038 M cubic feet for industrial use; 303,541 M cubic feet for commercial use; 194,390 M cubic feet for house heating, and 10,293 M cubic feet for other uses.

Sales of natural gas during February amounted to 3,758,935 M cubic feet, of which 2,112,207 M cubic feet was for domestic use, 997,530 M cubic feet for commercial use, 599,013 M cubic feet for industrial use, and 50,185 M cubic feet for other uses.
