SALES OF MANUFACTURED AND NATURAL GAS

MARCH - 1943

Sales of manufactured gas by distributing companies in Canada totalled 1,732,741 M cubic feet in March. Of this amount, 775,353 M cubic feet was for domestic use, other than house heating; 458,653 M cubic feet for industrial use; 303,844 M cubic feet for commercial use; 184,301 M cubic feet for house heating, and 10,590 M cubic feet for other uses.

Sales of natural gas during March amounted to 3,395,117 M cubic feet, of which 1,750,814 M cubic feet was for domestic use, 901,417 M cubic feet for commercial use, 687,831 M cubic feet for industrial use, and 55,055 M cubic feet for other uses.
