SALES OF MANUFACTURED AND NATURAL GASAPRIL - 1943

Sales of manufactured gas by distributing companies in Canada totalled 1,696,781 M cubic feet in April. Of this amount, 784,637 M cubic feet was for domestic use, other than house heating; 450,707 M cubic feet for industrial use; 304,721 M cubic feet for commercial use; 146,937 M cubic feet for house heating, and 9,779 M cubic feet for other uses.

Sales of natural gas during April amounted to 2,812,924 M cubic feet, of which 1,516,732 M cubic feet was for domestic use, 685,954 M cubic feet for commercial use, 544,361 M cubic feet for industrial use, and 65,877 M cubic feet for other uses.
