MONTHLY SALES OF MANUFACTURED AND NATURAL GAS - JANUARY, 1947

Sales of manufactured gas by distributing companies in Canada totalled 2,409,090 M cubic feet during January, 1947. Of this amount, 1,262,906 M cubic feet were for domestic use, other than house heating; 390,406 M cubic feet for industrial use; 395,037 M cubic feet for commercial use; 389,916 M cubic feet for house heating; and 20,825 M cubic feet for other uses.

Sales of natural gas during January, 1947, amounted to 5,181,745 M cubic feet, of which 2,827,314 M cubic feet were for domestic use; 1,257,392 M cubic feet for commercial use; 1,081,512 M cubic feet for industrial use, and 15,527 M cubic feet for other uses.

Explanatory Notes

Some customers are served with mixed manufactured and natural gas. The numbers of such customers are recorded only under the heading of natural gas, but the sales figures include the estimated quantities and values of each kind of gas under the proper headings.

Industrial customers include manufacturers, foundries, machine shops, wholesale bakeries, commercial laundries, etc.

Commercial customers include hotels, restaurants, retail bakers, delicatessens, tailor shops, department stores, wholesale dealers, professional and business offices, etc.

Sales figures represent sales by distributing companies to customers. Amounts used by producers are not included.
