## MONTHLY SALES OF MANUFACTURED AND NATURAL GAS - NOVEMBER, 1947

Sales of manufactured gas by distributing companies in Canada totalled 2.194.350 M cubic feet during November, 1947. Of this amount, 1,259,391 M cubic feet were for domestic use, other than house heating; 293,071 M cubic feet for industrial use; 449,863 M cubic feet for commercial use; 190,668 M cubic feet for house heating, and 1,357 M cubic feet for other uses.

Sales of natural gas during November, 1947 amounted to 3,701,679 M cubic feet, of which 1,738,058 M cubic feet were for domestic use; 873,754 M cubic feet for commercial use; 1,070,393 M cubic feet for industrial use; 19,474 M cubic feet for other uses.

Industrial customers include manufacturers, foundries, machine shops, wholesale bakeries, commercial laundries, etc.

Commercial customers include hotels, restaurants, retail bakers, delicatessens, tailor shops, department stores, wholesale dealers, professional and business offices, etc.

Sales figures represent sales by distributing companies to customers. Amounts used by producers are not included.
