## SALES OF MANUFACTURED AND NATURAL GAS IN CATADA - FEBRUARY, 1948

Sales of manufactured gas by distributing companies in Canada totalled $2,464,997 \mathrm{M}$ cubic feet during February, 1948. Of this amount, $1,356,348 \mathrm{M}$ cubic feet were for domestic use, other than house heating; 294, 738 M cubic feet for industrial use; $450,649 \mathrm{M}$ cubic feet for commercial use; $361,816 \mathrm{Mcubic}$ feet for house heating, and 1,446 M cubic feet for other uses.

Sales of natural gas during February, 1948 , amounted to $5,236,425 \mathrm{M}$ cubic feet, of which 2, $865,266 \mathrm{M}$ cubic feet were for domestic use; $1,300,627 \mathrm{M}$ cubic feet for commercial use; $1,056,237 \mathrm{M}$ cubic feet for industrial use; $14,295 \mathrm{M}$ cubic feet for other uses.

Some customers are served with mixed manufacturod and natural gas. The numbers of such customers are recorded only under the heading of natural gas, but the sales figures include the estimated quantitios and values of each kind of gas under the proper headings.

Industrial customers includo menuiacturers, foundrios, machine shops, wholesalo bakerios, commercial laundrics, etc.

Commercial customers include hotuls, restaurants, retail bakers, delicatessens, tailor shops, department stores, wholesale dealers, professional and business offices, etc.

Sales figures roprosent sales by distributing companios to customers. Amounts used by producers aro not included.
