## 1.ONTILY SA:TSS OF MANUFACTURED AND NATURAI GAS - JULY, 1948

Sales of manufactured gas by distributing companies in Canada totalled 1,707,467 W cubic feet during July 1948. Of this amount, $956,037 \mathrm{M}$ cubic feet were for domestic use, other than house heating; $328,211 \mathrm{k}$ cubic feet for industrial use; 389,927 $\mathbb{1 5}$ cubic feet for commercial use; 32,161 M cubic feet for house heating, and 1,131 K cubic feet for other uses.

Sales of natural gas during July 1948 amounted to $1,793,772 \mathrm{M}$ cubic feet, of which $629,613 \mathrm{M}$ cubic feet were for domestic use; 242,361 k cubic feet for commercial use; 904,291 10 cubic feet for industrial use; and $17,507 \mathrm{M}$ cubic feet for other uses.

## Explanatory Notes

Some customers are sarved with mixed manufactured and natural gas. The numbers of such customers are recorded only under the heading of Natural Gas, but the sales figures include the estimatad quantities and valuas of aach iind of gas under the proper headings.

Industrial customers include manufacturers, foundries, machine shops, wholesale bakerios, commercial laundries, etc.

Commercial customers include hotels, restaurants, retail bakers, dellcatessens, tailor shops, department storəs, wholesale dealers, professional and business offices, өtc.

Sales figures reprasont salos by distributing companies to customers. Amounts used by producers are not included. Saies of propane gas are not included.
