

SALES OF MANUFACTURED AND NATURAL GAS

October, 1959

Natural gas sales in October rose 44.5 per cent this year to 22,597,180 MCF from 15,642,319 in 1958. During the first ten months of 1959, natural gas sales increased 38.6 per cent to 221,837,441 MCF from the comparable 1958 total of 160,022,677.

The number of customers using natural gas increased 11.4 per cent to 1,097,525 from 985,627 in October, 1958.

Revenue from natural gas sales in October rose 46.6 per cent this year to \$12,190,224 from \$8,316,108 one year earlier. During the first ten months of 1959 revenue increased 39.2 per cent to \$123,789,930 from the comparable 1958 total of \$88,921,520.

Natural gas sales to industrial consumers during October attained a higher level than in any previous month during 1959 and 1958. Industrial sales of 13,201,226 MCF were 52.1 per cent greater than the 1958 total of 8,677,426 MCF. Sales to domestic customers increased 40.7 per cent to 6,234,183 MCF from 4,429,614 in October, 1958 and sales to commercial customers rose 24.6 per cent to 3,153,800 MCF from 2,530,303.

Sales in Alberta during October totalled 11,117,674 MCF, 49.2 per cent of the total for Canada. Alberta accounted for 42.9 per cent of domestic sales, 49.4 per cent of industrial sales and 60.9 per cent of commercial sales. Ontario, however, received the greatest revenue from sales, obtaining 46.7 per cent of the total for Canada, 47.1 per cent of the revenue from domestic sales, 51.3 per cent from industrial and 36.4 per cent from commercial sales.

Sales of manufactured gas continued to decline, down 13.4 per cent to 95,416 MCF from 110,123 in October last year. For the ten month period sales decreased 78.4 per cent to 1,180,910 MCF from 5,472,893. The number of customers using manufactured gas decreased to 30,439 from 32,376 in October, 1958 and revenue from sales decreased to \$159,879 from \$176,211. Revenue per MCF of manufactured gas was \$1.68, considerably higher than the average rate for Canada of \$0.54 per MCF for natural gas.

Classification of Gas Sales

- (a) Domestic sales of gas for residential use, including house heating.
- (b) Industrial sales to industrial and manufacturing concerns such as manufacturers of chemicals, machinery, textiles, foodstuffs, as well as foundries, machine shops, wholesale bakeries, commercial laundries, etc.
- (c) Commercial sales to hotels, restaurants, retail bakers, delicatessens, tailor shops, department stores, wholesale dealers, professional and business offices, etc.
- (d) Miscellaneous includes all sales not classified above. Does not include sales to other distributing companies.
- N.B. In order to facilitate early compilation of these reports, the current monthly statistics contained herein include some preliminary estimates. However, actual figures, upon becoming available, are substituted for estimates in the cumulative totals. Hence, the addition of monthly totals may not agree with the cumulative figures.
