#### SALES OF MANUFACTURED AND NATURAL GAS

December, 1959

Sales of natural gas in December rose 19.9 per cent to 32,166,506 MCF from 26,819,913 MCF one year ago. The number of customers rose 8.3 per cent to 1,119,161 from 1,032,930 and revenue from sales increased 30.3 per cent to \$19,749,480 from \$15,154,580.

For the twelve months ended December 31, 1959, natural gas sales increased 36.7 per cent to 282,358,928 MCF from the 1958 total of 206,553,170. During this period revenue from sales rose 38.9 per cent to \$159,627,745 from \$114,946,088.

Natural gas sales to industrial customers totalled 13,242,369 MCF, 29.8 per cent more than the total in December, 1958 of 10,199,581. Sales to domestic customers increased 15.3 per cent to 13,156,295 MCF from 11,406,402 last year and sales to commercial customers increased 10.6 per cent to 5,754,364 MCF from 5,204,077.

Sales in Alberta during December totalled 14,018,672 MCF, 43.6 per cent of the total for Canada. Alberta accounted for 34.5 per cent of domestic sales, 49.2 per cent of industrial sales and 51.4 per cent of commercial sales. Ontario recorded greatest revenue from sales, obtaining 50.7 per cent of the total, 53.5 per cent of the revenue from domestic sales, 52.5 per cent from industrial and 39.6 per cent from commercial sales.

Sales of manufactured gas totalled 145,097 MCF, down 6.9 per cent from the total in December last year of 155,906. For the twelve-month period sales decreased 74.7 per cent to 1,448,997 MCF from 5,729,129. The number of customers using manufactured gas during December declined to 30,192 from 31,899 in December, 1958. Revenue from sales at \$219,812, was slightly less than the \$221,760 of one year ago. Revenue per MCF of manufactured gas was \$1.51, considerably higher than the average of \$0.61 per MCF for natural gas.

#### Classification of Gas Sales

- (a) Domestic sales of gas for residential use, including house heating.
- (b) Industrial sales to industrial and manufacturing concerns such as manufacturers of chemicals, machinery, textiles, foodstuffs, as well as foundries, machine shops, wholesale bakeries, commercial laundries, etc.
- (c) Commercial sales to hotels, restaurants, retail bakers, delicatessens, tailor shops, department stores, wholesale dealers, professional and business offices, etc.
- (d) Miscellaneous includes all sales not classified above. Does not include sales to other distributing companies.
- N.B. In order to facilitate early compilation of these reports, the current monthly statistics contained herein include some preliminary estimates. However, actual figures, upon becoming available, are substituted for estimates in the cumulative totals. Hence, the addition of monthly totals may not agree with the cumulative figures.
