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### SALES OF MANUFACTURED AND NATURAL GAS

Total sales of natural gas during March, 1959 amounted to 29,246,826 MCF, any CF THE 37.5 per cent increase over the March, 1958 level of 21,274,146 MCF, but an 8.9 per cent decrease from the February total of 32,121,136 MCF. The number of customers using natural gas increased 54.4 per cent to 1,051,047 in March of this year from 680,599 in the corresponding month of the previous year and increased by 2,974 customers over the total of 1,048,073 in February, 1959. During this period revenue from sales increased 41.0 per cent to \$17,043,884 from \$12,091,908 in March 1958, but decreased 9.6 per cent from \$18,867,593 in the previous month.

Sales of natural gas to industrial customers continued to increase. Total for March was 11,909,451 MCF, a rise of 4,983,827 MCF or 71.7 per cent over the total of 6,925,624 MCF in March, 1958 and an increase of 843,624 MCF or 7.6 per cent over the total industrial sales of 11,065,827 MCF in February.

Natural gas sales in Alberta equalled 13,486,639 MCF or 46.1 per cent of the total sales in March, 1959. Of the sales to industrial and commercial users, Alberta consumed more than any other province, 51.6 per cent and 57.3 per cent of the national totals respectively, while Eastern Canada consumed the greater portion, 44.0 per cent, of the gas sold to domestic users.

Revenue from sales was greatest in Eastern Canada, 60.4 per cent of the total. This region also received the largest amount of revenue from each type of sales - domestic 64.4 per cent, industrial 62.1 per cent, and commercial 46.6 per cent.

Average rates varied greatly with the lowest in the main producing province of Alberta, \$0.24 per MCF while highest was in Eastern Canada, \$1.00 per MCF. These differences were largely caused by varying transportation costs. Rates to industrial users in all areas were much lower than rates to either domestic or commercial users.

Sales of manufactured gas continued to decline sharply, dropping 88.9 per cent to 141,874 MCF in March of this year from 1,277,263 MCF in March, 1958. The average rate, \$1.47 per MCF, was considerably higher than the average rate for Canada of \$0.58 per MCF of natural gas.

#### Classifications of Gas Sales

- (a) Domestic sales of gas for residential use, including house heating.
- (b) Industrial sales to industrial and manufacturing concerns such as manufacturers of chemicals, machinery, textiles, foodstuffs, as well as foundries, machine shops, wholesale bakeries, commercial laundries, etc.
- (c) Commercial sales to hotles, restaurants, retail bakers, delicatessens, tailor shops, department stores, wholesale dealers, professional and business offices, etc.
- (d) Miscellaneous includes all sales not classified above. Does not include sales to other distributing companies.
