SALES OF MANUFACTURED AND NATURAL GAS

March, 1960

In order to ensure that statistics are presented on a uniform basis, gas utilities have been asked, as of January 1960, to report MCF sold at 14.73 p.s.i.a., 60° F. and 1,000 BTU (for natural gas) or 500 BTU (for manufactured gas). In past years there have been some slight differences among companies regarding pressure, temperature and heat value conditions at which gas volumes were reported. Therefore, the volume of gas sold during 1958 and 1959 was recalculated at the specified standards and was published in the February, 1960 report. For comparison purposes, March, 1959 data are shown herein on the revised basis. It may be noted that the revisions are very minor.

Sales of liquified petroleum gas, which were previously included with sales of manufactured gas, are now tabulated separately. In order to properly assess the trend of manufactured gas sales, this breakdown for 1958 and 1959 sales was provided in the February, 1960 report.

Total sales of natural gas during March, 1960 amounted to 36,465,232 MCF, an increase of 30.7 per cent above the 27,909,429 MCF recorded in March, 1959 and 1.7 per cent above the 35,862,766 MCF sold in the previous month. The number of customers using natural gas rose 8.2 per cent to 1,135,000 from 1,049,256 in March, 1959 and revenue from sales increased 35.9 per cent to \$22,688,498 from \$16,691,479.

Natural gas sales to industrial customers totalled 14,058,194 MCF, 26.0 per cent greater than the March, 1959 total of 11,157,814 MCF. Sales to domestic customers rose 31.4 per cent to 15,624,485 MCF from 11,888,504 one year earlier and sales to commercial customers increased 39.5 per cent to 6,765,572 MCF from 4,849,491.

Sales in Alberta during March totalled 15,959,247 MCF, 43.8 per cent of the total for Canada. Alberta accounted for 35.8 per cent of the domestic sales, 48.5 per cent of industrial sales and 52.2 per cent of the commercial sales. Ontario continued to maintain the largest provincial portion of revenue from sales, obtaining 51.4 per cent of the total revenue,54.2 per cent of the revenue from domestic sales, 53.1 per cent from industrial and 40.8 per cent from commercial sales.

Classification of Gas Sales

- (a) Domestic sales of gas for residential use, including house heating.
- (b) Industrial sales to industrial and manufacturing concerns such as manufacturers of chemicals, machinery, textiles, foodstuffs, as well as foundries, machine shops, wholesale bakeries, commercial laundries, etc.
- (c) Commercial sales to hotels, restaurants, retail bakers, delicatessens, tailor shops, department stores, wholesale dealers, professional and business offices, etc.
- (d) Miscellaneous includes all sales not classified above. Does not include sales to other distributing companies.
- N.B. In order to facilitate early compilations of these reports, the current monthly statistics contained herein include some preliminary estimates. However, actual figures, upon becoming available, are substituted for estimates in the cumulative totals. Hence, the addition of monthly totals may not agree with the cumulative figures.
