
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SALES OF MANUFACTURED AND NATURAL GAS

MARCH, 1961

Sales of natural gas totalled 38,582,057 Mcf. in March 3.8 per cent higher than the 37,153,-343 Mcf. for the same month last year. Revenue from these sales increased 4.3 per cent to \$24,155,923 from \$23,160,567 and the number of customers rose 6.9 per cent to 1,213,992 from 1,135,855. For the three month period ended March 31, 1961 natural gas sales increased 10.5 per cent to 121,036,044 Mcf. from the previous year's 109,542,752 Mcf. and revenue from sales grew 13.7 per cent to \$78,604,971 from \$69,119,422.

Residential and commercial sales decreased this month, residential sales 6.0 per cent to 15,002,391 Mcf. from the previous year's 15,968,181 Mcf. and commercial sales 1.6 per cent to 6,775,386 Mcf. from 6,884,451 Mcf. This decrease was more than offset by the increase, 17.6 per cent, in industrial sales. The decrease in residential and commercial sales is accounted for in part by abnormally warm weather in all of Canada compared with March, 1959. New Brunswick, Quebec, Manitoba and British Columbia had increases in residential sales while increases in commercial sales occurred in New Brunswick, Quebec, Ontario, Manitoba and British Columbia.

Total sales for the twelve month period ending March 31 amounted to 335,961,696 Mcf.

In March net receipts into distribution systems totalled 38,596,625 Mcf. of natural gas. Of this 17,059,826 Mcf. was received directly from gathering system or processing plants and 21,525,-479 Mcf. was received from Canadian transmission systems. Receipts from storage were 87,199 Mcf.

Sales to ultimate consumers accounted for 38,582,057 Mcf. and 116,468 was delivered to storage.

Total net receipts of transmission and distribution systems combined amounted to 54,009,515 Mcf. Total net deliveries out of these systems equalled 54,369,738 Mcf. and included deliveries of 15,787,681 Mcf. to the United States. During March 3,124,750 Mcf. were received from storage while 1,513,930 Mcf. were delivered into storage. The contraseasonal increase in receipts from the February total is accounted for by increases in exports and storage.

Volumes of natural gas and liquefied petroleum gases are measured in cubic feet of 1,000 British thermal units at 14.73 pounds per square inch absolute and at $60^{\circ}F$. Volumes of manufactured gas are measured in cubic feet of 500 British thermal units at 14.73 pounds per square inch absolute and at $60^{\circ}F$. Volumes in this report are given in thousands of cubic feet (Mcf.).
