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SALES OF MANUFACTURED AND NATURAL GAS

JANUARY, 1962

Natural gas sales in January increased 19.8 per cent to 50,493,689 Mcf. from 42,161,359 Mcf. in January last year; revenue from sales increased 20.0 per cent to \$33,157,411 from \$27,636,661 and number of customers increased 7.0 per cent to 1,292,691 from 1,208,210.

Residential sales increased 25.2 per cent to 22,950,587 Mcf. and accounted for 45.4 per cent of all sales. Revenue from residential sales increased 20.8 per cent and accounted for 61.5 per cent of the total revenue. The total number of customers in this category increased 7,700 from December and 78,900 from last January.

Ontario residential sales, which accounted for 39.4 per cent of the Canadian volume and 52.2 per cent of the revenue, increased 12.6 per cent from last January. Alberta accounted for 31.2 per cent of the sales volume and 15.6 per cent of the revenue in this category with sales increasing by 34.5 per cent. Part of the increase in domestic sales in Ontario was a result of more space heating customers than in January 1961, and in Western Canada, the rise in consumption was due in part to a colder month than in the previous year.

Industrial sales, which made up 34.4 per cent of the total volume and 18.8 per cent of the total revenue, increased 9.4 per cent to 17,363,882 Mcf. Alberta was the largest user of industrial gas, taking 42.6 per cent followed by Ontario, 33.5 per cent.

Commercial sales constituted 20.2 per cent of total sales and 19.7 per cent of the revenue. These sales increased 27.8 per cent to 10,179,220 Mcf. in January. Alberta had the largest share of the commercial sales, 46.9 per cent, followed by Ontario, 26.6 per cent.

Space heating customers for January increased to 791,451 from 695,678 in January 1961.

Exports showed a substantial increase, to 29,461,219 Mcf. in January 1962 from 15,023,211 for January 1961.

Volumes of natural gas and liquefied petroleum gases in this report are given in thousands of cubic feet (Mcf.) of 1,000 British thermal units at 14.73 pounds per square inch absolute and at 60°F. Volumes of manufactured gas are given in thousands of cubic feet (Mcf.) of 500 British thermal units at 14.73 pounds per square inch absolute and at 60°F.

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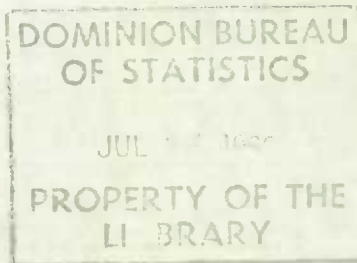
