SALES OF MANUFACTURED AND NATURAL GAS

OCTOBER 1962

Natural gas sales increased 2.1 per cent to 30,060,898 Mcf. from 29,439,945 Mcf. for the same period last year. Revenue from these sales increased 8.3 per cent to \$17,260,371 from \$15,938,441 and customers rose 6.5 per cent to 1,330,894 from 1,249,212.

Residential sales decreased 4.1 per cent to 6,766,219 Mcf. from 7,056,052 Mcf. last year and accounted for 22.5 per cent of all sales. Revenue from residential sales increased 7.5 per cent to \$8,068,109 from \$7,507,149 and accounted for 46.7 per cent of the total revenue. The number of residential customers rose 6.4 per cent to 1,217,993 from 1,144,449. Space heating customers increased 11.9 per cent to 838,820 including conversions as well as new customers.

Industrial sales had an increase of 6.3 per cent to 19,665,996 Mcf. from 18,498,296 Mcf. for last year and accounted for 65.4 per cent of the total volume and 37.4 per cent of the total revenue. Revenue from industrial sales rose 11.2 per cent to \$6,462,793 from \$5,812,733.

Sales to commercial customers decreased 6.6 per cent to 3,628,683 Mcf. from 3,885,597 Mcf. the previous year and accounted for 12.1 per cent of the total volume and 15.8 per cent of all revenue. Revenue from commercial sales increased to \$2,729,469 from \$2,618,559, up 4.2 per cent.

Ontario sales went up 27.3 per cent to 10,467,217 Mcf. from 8,225,076 Mcf. last year while Alberta decreased 4.6 per cent to 11,896,833 Mcf. from 12,471,849 Mcf. for the same month a year ago. Ontario accounted for the larger portion of revenue, 47.6 per cent.

For the ten month period ended October 31 natural gas sales totalled 338,355,276 Mcf., an increase of 13.2 per cent over last year's 298,791,373 Mcf. Revenue from sales increased 14.6 per cent to \$204,686,551 from \$178,547,050 last year.

Total sales for the twelve month period ending October 31 amounted to 416,627,964 Mcf.

Exports increased to 33,464,752 Mcf. from 12,360,763 Mcf. for the same period last year. For the ten month period January to October 1962 exports totalled 295,494,862 Mcf. compared with 136, 157,977 Mcf. for last year.

Volumes of natural gas and liquified petroleum gases in this report are given in thousands of cubic feet (Mcf.) of 1,000 British thermal units at 14.73 pounds per square inch absolute and at 60°F. Volumes of manufactured gas are given in thousands of cubic feet (Mcf.) of 500 British thermal units at 14.73 pounds per square inch absolute and at 60°F.
