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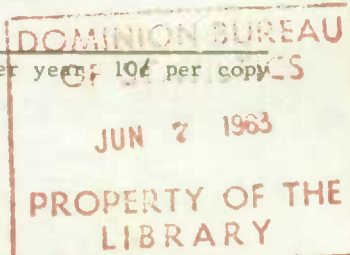
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SALES OF MANUFACTURED AND NATURAL GAS

JANUARY 1963



Sales of natural gas for January 1963, increased 7.4 per cent to 54,215,329 Mcf. from 50,493,689 Mcf. for the same month last year. Revenue from these sales increased to \$37,429,300 from \$33,157,411 a year ago.

Residential sales increased 6.7 per cent to 24,487,687 Mcf. from 22,950,587 Mcf. last year, and accounted for 45.2 per cent of all sales. Revenue rose to \$23,002,768 from \$20,383,350 last year, and made up 61.5 per cent of the total revenue. Customers rose 6.4 per cent to 1,258,346 from 1,182,707 last year, and space heating customers increased 12.0 per cent to 886,308, including conversions as well as new customers.

Industrial sales increased to 18,626,804 Mcf. from 17,363,882 Mcf. a year ago, and accounted for 34.4 per cent of the total volume and 18.7 per cent of the total revenue. Revenue from industrial sales rose 12.3 per cent to \$6,982,922 from \$6,226,080 last year.

Sales to commercial customers increased to 11,100,838 Mcf. from 10,179,220 Mcf. the previous year, and accounted for 20.5 per cent of the total volume and 19.9 per cent of the total revenue. Revenue from commercial sales increased to \$7,436,610 from \$6,547,981, up 13.6 per cent.

Ontario sales rose 14.8 per cent during January to 20,177,772 Mcf. from 17,583,125 Mcf. last year, while Alberta had a decrease of 2.9 per cent to 18,775,577 Mcf. from 19,338,969 Mcf. a year ago.

Exports increased to 34,618,023 Mcf. from 29,461,219 Mcf. for January 1962.

Total sales for the twelve-month period ending January 31 amounted to 423,750,713 Mcf.

This report contains several significant revisions in concept. In previous years the sales volumes were reported in cubic feet containing approximately 1,000 B.T.U.'s. Unfortunately, not all of the statistics collected were consistent, and it was difficult to relate these statistics to statistics on other sectors of the gas industry. Sales of natural gas in Tables 1, 2 and 3 of this report, therefore, are measured in Mcf. at 14.73 p.s.i.a. regardless of B.T.U. content. Tables 4, 5 and 6 report the sales volume in terms of cubic feet containing 1,000 B.T.U.'s. As a result, comparison with previous years are not precise, although they are close. Analysis of the differences arising in these changes will be made in the next few months, and reported in a future publication.
