SALES OF MANUFACTURED AND NATURAL GAS

NOVEMBER 1963

Sales of natural gas in Canada for November 1963 increased to 40,454,717 Mcf. from 37,394,944 Mcf. last year, up 8.2 per cent and revenue from these sales increased 4.5 per cent to \$24,904,430 from \$23,840,784.

Residential sales had a slight apparent decrease to 11,959,412 Mcf. from 11,968,279 Mcf. in 1962 and accounted for 29.6 per cent of the total sales. Revenue decreased to \$12,661,380 from \$12,775,302 last year and accounted for 50.8 per cent of the total revenues. Customers increased 5.9 per cent to 1,309,153 from 1,236,300 and space heating customers rose 10.4 per cent to 948,945, including conversions as well as new customers. The decline of residential sales for November 1963 was due to abnormally warm weather in Eastern Canada.

Industrial sales increased 13.9 per cent to 22,455,362 Mcf. from 19,713,428 Mcf. and accounted for 55.5 per cent of the total volume and 32.4 per cent of the total revenues. Revenue from industrial sales rose to \$8,070,970 from \$6,981,290, up 15.6 per cent over last year.

Sales to commercial customers increased 5.7 per cent to 6,039,943 Mcf. from 5,713,237 Mcf. a year ago and accounted for 14.9 per cent of the total volume. Revenue from commercial sales increased to \$4,172,080 from \$4,084,192 and accounted for 16.8 per cent of the total revenues.

Ontario sales for November 1963 decreased 2.5 per cent to 13,773,662 Mcf. from 14,118,519 Mcf. in 1962, while Alberta sales increased to 15,582,005 Mcf. from 13,301,145 Mcf., up 17.1 per cent.

Exports for November 1963 increased 7.9 per cent to 33,071,691 Mcf. from 30,646,014 Mcf. last year. For the twelve-month period ending November 30, 1963 exports amounted to 355,593,308 Mcf. Exports for 1962 have been revised and are now comparable to 1963. As a result the sharp decrease of 12.5 per cent given for October 1963 should only have been 7.6 per cent.

Sales of natural gas for the eleven-month period January to November 1963 totalled 404,667,645 Mcf. and revenue totalled \$253,153,223. Total sales in Canada for the twelve-month period ending November 30 amounted to 448,933,883 Mcf.

This report contains several significant revisions in concept. In previous years the sales volumes were reported in cubic feet containing approximately 1,000 B.T.U.'s. Unfortunately, not all of the statistics collected were consistent, and it was difficult to relate these statistics to statistics on other sectors of the gas industry. Sales of natural gas in Tables 1, 2 and 3 of this report, therefore, are measured in Mcf. at 14.73 p.s.i.a. regardless of B.T.U. content. Tables 4, 5 and 6 report the sales volume in terms of cubic feet containing 1,000 B.T.U.'s. As a result comparisons of sales with previous years are not precise, although they are close, the previous years being slightly overstated. Analysis of the differences arising from these changes are being made and will be reported in a future publication.


