SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to \$7,559,479 in February, 1955. Trade sales accounted for \$4,680,355 or about 62% and industrial sales for \$2,879,124 or about 38% of the total sales.
