## SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to \$9,158,199 in March, 1955. Trade sales accounted for \$5,739,696 or about 63% and industrial sales for \$3,418,503 or about 37% of the total sales.
