## SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production amounted to \$10,987,428 in April, 1955. Trade sales accounted for \$7,437,450 or about 68% and industrial sales for \$3,549,978 or about 32% of the total sales.
