SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERSOCTOBER, 1946

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to \$5,219,636 in October, 1946 compared with \$4,573,048 in September, 1946. In October the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 51 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 35 per cent, water paints for 3 per cent, and unclassified sales for 11 per cent.
