Monthly ReportonSALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERSNovember, 1946

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally accounted for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to \$4,714,725 in November, 1946, compared with \$5,219,686 in October, 1946. In November the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 48 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 38 per cent, water paints for 3 per cent and unclassified sales for 11 per cent.
