SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHTES AND LACQUERS

November, 1946

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally eccounted for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to $\$ 4,714,7 \% 5$ in November, 1946, compared with $\$ 5,219,686$ in October, 1946. In November the trade sales (exciusive of water paints) accounted for about 48 per cent of the total, industrial siles for 38 per cent, water paints for 3 per cent and unclassified sales for 11 per cont.
