Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally accounted for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to $\$ 3,968,551$ in D:cember, 1946, compared with $\$ 4,714,725$ in November, 1946. In December the trade sales (oxclusive of water paints) accounted for about 48 per cent of the total, industrial siles for 39 per cent, water paints for 2 per cent and unclassified sales for 11 per cent.
