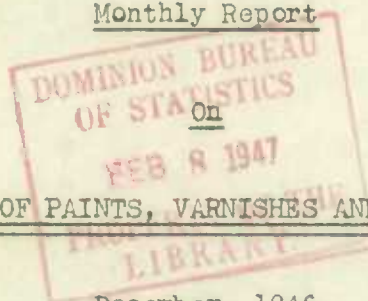

Monthly ReportSALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERSDecember, 1946.

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally accounted for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to \$3,968,551 in December, 1946, compared with \$4,714,725 in November, 1946. In December the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 48 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 39 per cent, water paints for 2 per cent and unclassified sales for 11 per cent.

TABLE OF VALUES, FACTORIES AND INDUSTRIES

1954-1955

Values of products, manufactured and imported by manufacturing, which normally accounted for 60 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to \$1,000,000 in 1954, 1955, compared with \$1,000,000 in 1953. The percentage of value added in manufacturing increased from 40 per cent of the total, industrial value for 1954 and 1955, to 45 per cent and 46 per cent respectively for 1954 and 1955.
