## SALES OF PAINIS, TARNISHES AND LAC QUERS

## AFRIL - 1946

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers which normally accounts for 96 per cent of the total Camadian production, amounted to $\$ 5,484,554$ in April. 1946 . compared with $\$ 4,680,798$ in March, 1946. In April the trade sales (exclusive of water paints accounted for about 52 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 35 per cent, water paints for 4 per cent and unclassified sales for 9 per cent.
