SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERSAPRIL - 1946

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers which normally accounts for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to \$5,484,554 in April, 1946, compared with \$4,680,798 in March, 1946. In April the trade sales (exclusive of water paints accounted for about 52 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 35 per cent, water paints for 4 per cent and unclassified sales for 9 per cent.
