Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Cenadicn production, amounted to $\$ 5,922,712$ in May, 194.6, compared with $\$ 5,484,554$ in April, 1946. In 4yrll the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 49 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 37 per cent, water paints for 4 per cent ind unciussified sales for 10 per cont.
