Sales of prints, varnishes and lacquers by menufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to $\$ 5,482,586$ in June, 1946, compared with ${ }_{4}^{*}, 922,712$ in May, 1946. In June the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 53 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 34 per cont, wetar paints for 3 per cent, and unclassified seles for 10 per cent.
