## AUGUST, 1946

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the tetal Canadian production, amounted to $\$ 4,899,623$ in August, 1946, compared with $\$ 4,965,209$ in July, 1946. In August the trade sales (oxclusive of water paints) accounted for about 47 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 38 per cent, water paints for 4 per cent, and unclassified sales for 11 per cent.
