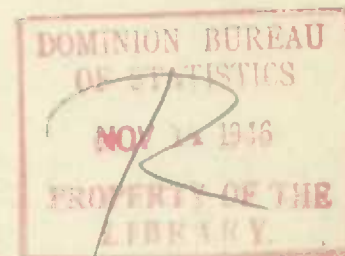

MONTHLY REPORT

ON

SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS

September, 1946



Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to \$4,573,048 in September, 1946, compared with \$4,899,623 in August, 1946. In September the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 51 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 38 per cent, water paints for 3 per cent, and unclassified sales for 8 per cent.
