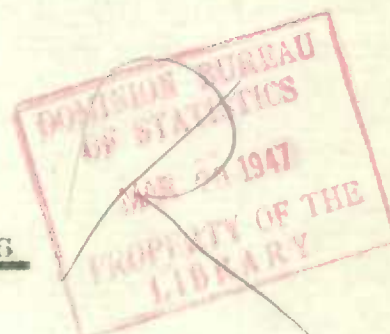

SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS

January, 1947.



Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally accounted for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to \$4,753,071 in January, 1947, compared with \$3,844,843 in January, 1946. In January, 1947 the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 48 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 39 per cent, water paints for 2 per cent and unclassified sales for 11 per cent.
