## SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS, OCTOBER, 1947

Sales of paints, vamishos and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to $\$ 6,352,437$ in October, 1947 compared with $\$ 5,586,300$ in September, 1947. In October, 1947 the trade salos (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 47 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 35 per cent, water paints for 3 per cent, and unclassified sales for 15 per cent.
