## SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS, NOVEMBER, 1947

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to \$5,717,284 in November 1947 compared with \$6,352,437 in October, 1947. In November, 1947 the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 46 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 37 per cent, water paints for 3 per cent, and unclassified sales for 14 per cent.
