## SAIES OF PAINTS, VARN ISHES AND LACQUERS, DECEMBER, 1947

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to $\$ 4,632,542$ in lecember, 1947 compared with $\$ 5,717,284$ in November, 1947. In December, 1947 the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 47 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 40 per cent, water paints for 3 per cent, and unclassified sales for 10 per cent.
