## SAIES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS, APRIL, 1947

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the tatal Canadian production, amounted to $\$ 6,624,964$ in April, 1947, compared with $\$ 6,588,378$ in March, 1947. In April, 1947 the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 55 per cent of the total, industrial sales for 34 per cent, water paints for 2 per cent, and unclassifled sales for 9 per cent.
