SALES OF PAINTS, VARNISHES AND LACQUERS, AUGUST, 1947

Sales of paints, varnishes and lacquers by manufacturers, which normally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to \$5,806,373 in August, 1947, compared with \$5,777,486 in July, 1947. In August, 1947, the trade sales (exclusive of water paints) accounted for about 50 per cent of the total; industrial sales for 55 per cent; water paints for 2 per cent, and unclassified sales for 13 per cent.
