## GALES OF PATND, VIUNTABES AUD LACQURE, AUGUST, 1947

Sales of paints, varniches and lacquers by manufacturers, which nomally account for 96 per cent of the total Canadian production, amounted to $\$ 5,806,37.3$ in Ausust, 1947, compared with ${ }^{\beta} 5,777,486$ in July, 1947. In Aucust, 1947, the trade seles (eaclusive of water paints) accounted for about 50 per cent of the total; inductrial sales for 35 per ceut; water paints for 2 per cent, and unclassified sales for 13 per cent.
